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Subject: Camouflage Painting of Ships Assigned to the Atlantic Fleet.

Reference: (a) Ship Camouflage Instructions United States Navy (Ships-2) June 1942.


1. Ships under construction and ships being converted that are assigned to the Atlantic Fleet should be painted in accordance with camouflage instructions contained in reference (a) as follows:

(a) Submarines - Measure 9.

(b) Surface Ships - Measure 22.

2. Ships that have been painted in accordance with any measure prescribed in Ships-2 need not be repainted to comply with the above.
